

PROPOSING AT THE GALILEO

The Galileo Open Air Cinema provides the ideal romantic setting to ask the once-in-a-lifetime question in the most memorable way. With romantic classics on screen throughout the season, you can create an everlasting memory with your loved one.

BOOKING PROCEDURE

1. View the season lineup by visiting <https://thegalileo.co.za/movies/>.
2. Submit date choice to office@thegalileo.co.za to confirm we are able to host your proposal on your chosen date.
3. Buy tickets to the desired show by visiting <http://thegalileo.co.za/movies/> and pay the R300 proposal fee to The Galileo.
4. Make a video OR slideshow (not both) of no longer than 90 seconds that you would like to project onto the screen (longer material will not be accepted).
5. Send the video/slideshow to The Galileo for approval at least two weeks before your proposal date.
6. Should changes need to be made, The Galileo will let you know and you'll need to resubmit your material.

ORDER OF EVENTS

Proposals at The Galileo adhere to the following process:

1. Check the doors open time.
2. Try and arrive early while it is still light and empty so you get a good spot.
3. Make sure you tell the staff where you are sitting – we will need to know this.
4. Your proposal video/slideshow will start roughly 15 minutes before the start of the movie (check our website for exact start times).
5. Adverts & trailers play.
6. The movie plays.



VIDEO/SLIDESHOW SPECS

Video

Videos should be recorded in high resolution (1920 x 1080 pixels) and should be in AVI or MP4 format.

Submissions must be sent via Dropbox or WeTransfer to office@thegalileo.co.za as early as possible (latest two weeks before your proposed date).

Should any edits be required, the updated video should be resubmitted for approval (The Galileo will not make any changes to the video).

The final video must be finished at least one week before the date you wish to propose or else we cannot accommodate you.

Once the final video has been approved, the proposal will be added to the on-screen line-up for the desired date.

A microphone is available should you wish to use it.

Slideshow

Slideshows should be developed in Microsoft PowerPoint.

Under Design > Slide Size, set the page size to On Screen Show (16:9) – very important.

Please note:

- As a guide, each slide should be visible for 8-10 seconds, depending on how much writing is on each slide. Make sure you watch it a few times and ensure the length of time is correct on each slide.
- Make sure you leave at least a 10% border on each slide as the sides of the image may be lost when projecting on the screen.
- Sound should be added to the video or slideshow.
- Submissions must be sent to office@thegalileo.co.za for approval at least two weeks before your proposal date.
- Should any edits be required, The Galileo will let you know and you will need to resubmit your presentation (The Galileo will not make any changes to the slideshow).
- The final video or slideshow must be finished at least one week before the date you wish to propose.
- Once the video or slideshow has been approved, the proposal will be added to the on-screen line-up for the desired date.
- A microphone is available should you wish to use it.
